A recent Barna Survey results from Millennial parents (age 27–42) were deplorable: less than 35% of “born-again” parents embraced absolute moral truth, that Christ is the only way to God, and other basic tenets of the Christian faith. **The question remains: what is the likelihood their children will cast off Christianity altogether?**

George Barna nailed the solution when he summarized his survey: “Unfortunately, many parents get caught up in the turbulence and demands of daily life and lose sight of how biblical principles should inform their choices. **Most born-again parents regularly attend church services but do not receive the kind of systematic and biblical equipping they so desperately need** to guide their own lives and to help them develop their children into dynamic disciples of Jesus.”¹
