Zan Tyler homeschooled her three children from kindergarten through high school for a total of 21 years. When Zan began homeschooling in 1984, she was threatened with jail by the State Superintendent of Education in SC. Little did she know then that this would lead to an eight-year journey of freedom-fighting for homeschoolers in her state. Zan founded the South Carolina Association of Independent Home Schools (SCAIHS), which allows homeschoolers to homeschool legally and with tons of support — without ever having to interact with the public school system.
