PASSING ON THE FAITH

Dear Friend,

I spoke to my 90-year-old mother earlier today about my latest book. She gave me an A+...Thanks Mom! She still grades my stuff after all these years.

Mom was the inspiration behind this ministry at the beginning—pushing for a Jesus-centered, biblically-based, Christian curriculum in all subjects.

Dad and Mom homeschooled us in the 1960s, 1970s, and 1980s. There was still too much conventional school, too much secular flavor in homeschooling and Christian curriculum, and they wanted something better.

When we homeschooled our own children in the 1990s and 2000s, we were still looking for something with a better integration of Scripture, and a more self-consistent biblical worldview under it all.

That's why Generations... for our children, our grandchildren, and great-grandchildren.

Homeschooling is not enough. Classical schools are not enough. Church youth groups are not enough. Christian families around the world are desperate for generational faith, which entails a more robust discipleship vision for their children.

We captured this vision early—the need for a God-centered, family-based discipleship model—not the Greek model, not the socialist model, not the institutionalized model, and certainly not the humanist model that's passed off as "education."

I firmly believe that education is ground zero in the battle over the hearts and minds of the next generation. This is where the enemy has unleashed his most intense firepower. This is where the Great Commission begins—in the home, through family discipleship.

And now, with the failure of secular schools and the growing hunger for biblical alternatives, we believe this is the moment. I believe this is a God-ordained opportunity to recover our Christian heritage at home and disciple the nations abroad. There is no better strategy. This is how real transformation happens.

Ten years ago, we sensed God calling us to build a curriculum that matched the family discipleship vision set out in Deuteronomy 6:7, Ephesians 6:4, and the Book of Proverbs.

- Where the secular nations took the Bible out of every textbook, we're bringing the Bible back—into every chapter, and sometimes every page.
- Where they took Jesus out, we're bringing Him back.
- Where they removed prayer, reverence, and the fear of God, we're putting it all back in.

We want the awesomeness of God front and center, in every subject, **including science, history, literature, and even... math.**

And it's not just education. **We're calling families to take a radically God-centered approach to every aspect of family life—relationships, parenting, church engagement, family economics, and so much more. Today, we are equipping them with radically God-centered resources so that God will be at the center of everything in their family life.**

This is how we pass on the faith.

Honestly, at the beginning, I wasn't sure where this would go.

I had no idea how God might use this little ministry and its radical approach to impact hundreds of thousands of families through our discipleship resources.

Today, Generations has become the Christian family discipleship ministry with a footprint in over one hundred countries around the world, over a million media downloads, and over one hundred thousand discipleship resources distributed in the last year. We provide vision and resources. However, we know that's just the beginning of what needs to happen.

Without the Spirit of God moving in the hearts of parents and children, there will be no progress made in generational faith anywhere in the world.

That's why I say that Generations is a prayer—a crying out that God would turn the hearts of fathers to their children and children to their fathers... and that all hearts would turn back to Him. And you know what? God's Spirit is moving, and we're excited to share that story with you in the rest of this pamphlet.

But let me say this. One of the ways God's Spirit has moved mightily is through the phenomenal generosity of our partners. **We praise God for you**, and we can honestly say that God has multiplied the seed you have sown and increased the fruits of your righteousness (2 Cor. 9:10). Truly it's all by the grace of God!

Where are we going from here?

In the all-wise, all-good counsels of God, this was the year we lost Charlie Kirk, James Dobson, Voddie Baucham, John MacArthur, and Phil Robertson—all well-known Christians from diverse backgrounds who agreed on one thing—**get out of the secular schools and disciple your kids for Jesus.**

We intend to carry on this legacy.

Let me be blunt. In order to sustain and to grow the **Christian church in the future, Christian families will have to abandon secular education and come on board the Ephesians 6:4 vision, period.**

I have traveled the world—10 international trips in the last year and a half. (Photo: Brenda and me with homeschool leaders in Portugal.) This much I have discovered—Christians everywhere are done with secular, statist educational systems.

And, we want to be there to help them.



We want to harvest this growth, reproduce this growth, cheerlead this growth, and supplement this growth. We are praying and preparing for 50 million Christians to be on board with this vision by 2050, and we believe God is calling us to be a part of it.

We call this our 50/50 Vision.

Our next major step toward this vision is to offer the Generations God-centered K-12 curriculum in an online format for families all around.

But there's something else. We plan to offer it 100% free of charge.

If family-based discipleship and education is central to the Great Commission (*and it is!*), there is no reason money should stand in the way of God's people providing God-centered education to the nations of the world.

We've already released the first beta-tested version. And in 2026, we plan to launch the full release.

I couldn't be more excited!

We believe this is a moment of convergence: The content is ready. The technology is available. The hunger is real.

It sounds like an impossible vision—but we've already seen God go before us opening up Red Seas, doing the unexpected along the way.

So we're pressing on in faith. As Hosea 6:3 reminds us:

"Let us press on to know the LORD... **he will come to us as the showers**, as the spring rains that water the earth."

This is the vision! God's Spirit coming down on families all over the world as spring rain, and turning the ashes of a God-forsaken culture into fruitful gardens that display the glory of God's redeeming grace!

Let me close with this. During the early days of our curriculum development (in 2012), God laid it on the heart of a solitary donor to provide us with a gift that was orders of magnitude beyond anything we had ever received to date. We took this as a call from God to steward His resources and bring a significant kingdom return to the investment. This we did, by the grace of God—and nine years later we had achieved the expected ROI.

That gift was a turning point.

Now, we believe we are at another turning point. Once again, we stand at the edge of the Red Sea, looking to God in confidence that He will make a way for us.

The remainder of this pamphlet lays out more of the vision, the accomplishments, and the calling of this ministry.



Podcasts

In a world full of noise, families are hungry for clarity, conviction, and Christ-centered teaching. Through our podcast lineup—including *Generations Radio*, *The World View in 5 Minutes*, *Raising Them Up*, and *Passing on the Faith*—we’re helping parents reclaim their calling, refocus their homes, and rejoice in the Gospel every day.

We’ve heard from countless listeners who are using these podcasts as part of their daily rhythm—listening at the breakfast table, in the car, or during family worship. One dad told us how discussions sparked by *Generations Radio* have shaped how he parents, how he teaches, and how his family worships—together.

In the last year, our podcasts surpassed **one million downloads**—and with God’s help, we’re pressing on to reach even more.

Homeschool Summits

In 2025, over 41,000 families joined us for two online Homeschool Summits—bringing biblical vision, practical tools, and Gospel hope to parents around the world.



Our spring event, Homeschool Curriculum, gathered 18,206 attendees and featured trusted voices like Ken Ham and Alex Newman.

Our fall event, Homeschool the Heart drew 23,335 participants, with powerful messages from leaders including Paul Tripp, Voddie Baucham, and Rosaria Butterfield.

These summits are more than webinars. They’re an anchor for families seeking Christ-first discipleship in the home—and a growing movement of parents saying yes to a new generation of faithfulness.

Events

This past year, our Father-Son Retreats and Shepherds Conference became a place for renewal—moments where men rediscovered what it means to lead with humility, courage, and faith.


At the retreats, fathers worshiped shoulder to shoulder with their sons, opened the Word together, and built memories that will echo for generations. Many arrived weary or unsure; they left with something more—a picture of godly manhood, a plan for intentional discipleship, and a people to walk beside them.

We've seen it again and again: when men lead in repentance and joy, homes change. Conversations deepen. Faith comes alive around the dinner table. Legacy takes root.

At our Shepherds Conference, more than 100 pastors, fathers, and church leaders gathered to grow in Gospel vision for their homes and congregations. The hunger was tangible, the fellowship rich, and the impact lasting. These events are not just weekends away—they're catalysts for generational faithfulness. And by God's grace, the ripple effects are reaching homes across the country.

God-Centered Curriculum

This year, we reached a major milestone: the launch of the **Generations Online Curriculum**—making our God-centered discipleship resources free to the world. Our full science program (grades 1–6) is already live, with history (grades 1–6) and reading (grades 1–5) coming soon. Designed for families at the kitchen table or believers across the globe, these tools bring the fear of the Lord back into education.

This is part of our 50/50 Vision: helping equip Christians around the world with free, Jesus-centered curriculum. Alongside our digital tools, we continue to expand our printed curriculum.

New for 2026:

- **Math 4**—A worship-oriented, life-application approach
- **Under God**—A bold, biblical civics course for teens
- **English 3 & 4**—Rooted in literature and biblical worldview

- **A Heidi Picture Book**—A tender tale of providence and redemption
- **A Robinson Crusoe Picture Book**—A story of survival, sovereignty, and salvation
- **A new collection of Great Christian Devotional Classics** to deepen roots in truth

These books are more than stories—they’re tools for forming hearts, shaping affections, and passing on the faith, one page at a time.





2026 VISION & GOALS

- ✓ **Online Development:** New tools and platform enhancements will make our K-12 discipleship curriculum available for free to families around the world.
- ✓ **Media Expansion:** We're planning to launch three new podcasts to meet parents and leaders right where they are:

- **A women's discipleship podcast** (yet to be titled) – Encouragement and biblical wisdom for women in every season of life
- **Man to Men** – A direct, biblical call to godly manhood


