Map Exercise

Required Items:

- Globe of the Earth, or “Google Earth Pro”
- Yarn
- Scotch tape or another removable adhesive that will not hurt the print on the globe.

Using the yarn and the globe, divide the world into four quarters with roughly equal amounts of land and water using only one north-south circle (meridian) and one circle around the middle of the earth, not necessarily the equator. You only need to tape the yarn at a few points to keep it from falling off. Take a photo when you’re finished. Then carefully remove all the yarn and tape from the globe.

Alternatively, if you have the free program “Google Earth Pro” on your computer, you can create the map using “Ruler” tool to draw lines on the globe.
